# Pa. Truck Centers plans Wrightsville dealership

Pennsylvania Truck Centers is constructing a new dealership in Wrightsville's Wrights Crossing Business Park, south of Route 30.

The 38,000-square-foot facility, on 13 acres, is set to open by June 30, creating about five jobs, said Pennsylvania Truck Centers president Drew

Behmer on Monday. Kinsley Construction is the project developer.

The Lancaster-based firm's new dealership will sell and service new and used Mack, Volvo, Isuzu and GMC commercial trucks and sell parts as well. Behmer declined to disclose the project cost.

Behmer said the new dealership, which Pennsylvania

Truck Centers will own, will replace a leased, smaller dealership on South Fayette Street, near West Market Street, in York.

That 28,000-square-foot facility, with about 35 employees, is the former home of York Mack. Pennsylvania Truck Centers acquired that dealership in December 2003, along with York's Snyder Vol-

vo, putting both at the Fayette Street site.

Pennsylvania Truck Centers also has locations on Keller Avenue, where it has its main office, and in Reading.

Handling the Wrightsville transaction was Dan Berger of NAI Commercial Partners.
